- 6) Suppliers who fail to make supplies or render services after quoting will be removed from the register of suppliers without notice.
- 7) Priority is given to the suppliers, who wish to provide credit facilities to the Institute, when purchasing items and the amount and period of credit available, should be indicated in the application.
